Nisan 19---Day 5 of Unleavened Bread....**Saturday**

Nisan 20---Day 6 of Unleavened Bread....**Sunday**

Nisan 21---Day 7 of Unleavened Bread—A Shabbat day of Rest....**Monday**

Biblical: Leavened bread may be eaten after sundown---Ex 12:18

Nisan 22---Day 8* of Unleavened Bread....**Tuesday**...for the Disapora

***Traditional Judaism** adds an 8th day to the Festival for people leaving outside of Israel to ensure that the celebration is in conformity with the New Moon. Judaism also declares this day to be a Shabbat.

Biblical: Feast of First Fruits---Begin Counting the Omer (Lev 23:11-16)
